

EXAMPLES OF JUDICIAL WARRANTS

You have a right to see a valid search or arrest warrant before permitting any law enforcement to enter or gather information!

Sample Warrants to Search a Place/Location:

1: Exact complete address required (redacted here)

1: Exact complete address required

2: Judge or Magistrate must be selected under the signature. The warrant is NOT a judicial warrant if only "clerk" is selected!

3: Expiration date must be current (not past)

NOTE: Not all warrants have expiration dates.

2: Signer must be a Judge or Magistrate

 Violation of Sec. 3-7 Gloucester County Code, Maintenance of animals and fowl, Sec. 3-13 Gloucester County Code, Cruelty to animals, Sec. 3-15 Gloucester County Code, Failure to perform duties of ownership, and Sec. 3.2-6570 Virginia State Code, Cruelty to animals. Owner is not taking proper care of animals that live on this property.
