Library	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Helped student get a library card ○ Explored children's area for bringing one's children ○ Used biography section to work on alphabetizing ○ Found books to read together
YMCA Pool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Learned about hours, facilities, cost and how to sign in
Student's Culture Restaurant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Talked about student's culture ○ Follow up: Wrote an Experience Story about it
Movie Theater	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Went to a matinee to see an iconic movie about American culture
Riverview Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 10 minutes from LV. ○ It has a paved, easy and accessible walking trail. It goes along the river and in a meadow area. Lots of birds to see. Some trees have markers identifying what kind of tree they are. It is a well-used park, so usually lots of people are around ○ Some benches along the way to view the river.
Monticello	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Toured and learned about history, inventions, etc. ○ Follow up: Read about Monticello, slavery, Jefferson
DMV	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Chatted with other people in line which gave my student a chance to engage in conversation with new acquaintances
Carter Mountain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Went Peach/Apple picking ○ Talked about history, farming, buying local, nutrition ○ Follow up: Researched recipes (e.g. baked apples)
Paramount Theater	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Took a tour together to see and learn about the history of this Cville icon (and Wordplay venue!)
UVA Grounds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Visited the Pavillion gardens, talked about fruit trees ○ Visited the Rotunda (including the Dome Room – usually open to the public) and Cabell Hall ○ Lots of opportunities for English conversation practice
Ivy Creek Reservoir	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Walked in the woods and looked at birds and turtles ○ It was a fun way to stimulate conversation
Afghan Market on 29	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Tutor learned about student's culture and gained new insights into a different aspect of gender roles in the student's culture
Dentist office	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Prep: talked about what, when, why, where, how of visit ○ Student talked and asked questions, tutor took notes ○ Discussed impressions, notes, next steps ○ Collected words to read and use in conversation
Gearharts Fine Chocolates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ We went to drink hot chocolate ○ Talked about how hot chocolate is different in student's country ○ Could work on using US currency for making a purchase
