



Introduction to HVAC with NCCER Core Craft for the English Language Learner

THE PROGRAM

This 166-hour Integrated Education Training program includes a technical introduction to Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) with English language instruction. The curriculum teaches the entry-level competencies for job success in the HVAC industry.

The training will be delivered in a hybrid format, with classroom instruction delivered virtually and hands-on exercises done in-person, in accordance with Virginia Social Distancing regulations. Masks are required at all times. In addition to earning NCCER credentials for core curriculum and HVAC, students will also earn CPR/First Aid and OSHA 10 training and credentials.
