Each group of sentences below is a paragraph, but the sentences are in the wrong order. Work with your tutor to:

1. Read all the sentences.
2. Decide which sentence should be first (topic sentence).
3. Put the sentences in the best order by writing the letters (A, B, C, D) in the correct sequence.

Paragraph 1: Daily Routine

A. After work, I usually cook dinner and spend time with my family.
 B. My daily routine helps me stay organized and productive.
 C. In the evening, I prepare my clothes and lunch for the next day.
 D. Every morning, I wake up at 6:00 and get ready for work.

Paragraph 2: Learning English

A. Now I feel more confident when I speak with people in my community.
 B. Learning English has been challenging, but it has helped me grow.
 C. At first, I was afraid to make mistakes when I spoke.
 D. I practiced by listening to English videos and talking with my tutor.

Paragraph 3: A Favorite Place

A. For these reasons, the park is one of my favorite places to visit.
 B. There are also walking paths where I can exercise and relax.
 C. The park near my home is a peaceful and beautiful place.
 D. It has many trees, flowers, and benches where people can sit.
