# Skype

- iOS, Android, Mac, Windows, Linux, web
- Desktop and mobile apps available
- Must download software
- Call limit: four hours per call, 100 hours per month
- Basic video call features
- Can screen share in “Meet Now”
- Traditionally all users need an account



# WhatsApp Messenger

- iOS, Android, Mac, Windows, web
- Must download software to computer or phone
- Both users need an account
- Basic text or video messaging
- Can send media files
- Many students already have it installed on their phones



# Marco Polo App

- iOS, Android
- Free app for phones
- No live chat option
- Send video messages in place of text messages
- Both users need an account



# Zoom

- iOS, Android, Mac, Windows
- Business video conferencing
- Desktop and mobile
- Lots of added features: screen sharing, whiteboard, annotations, breakout rooms
- Call limit: 40 minutes (limit currently removed) for groups
- Host needs an account
- Must download software



# Google Meet

- iOS, Windows, Android, Chrome OS, Linux, web
- Host needs a Google account
- Basic video conferencing
- Closed Caption feature
- Call limit: 60 minutes (extended to 24 hours until Sept. 30)
- No software downloads needed
- Limited “teaching” features
